- A start-up business
- Set up in 2008 by 3 inspirational young men, now 23 years old, in their home town of Newcastle, N Ireland
- While studying Civil Engineering, they were highly doubtful of securing jobs in their chosen field once they graduated, so they set up their own business instead
- Conduct energy assessments for building firms and councils across Ireland, and winning contracts in Great Britain too
- Work is centred on large graphics files produced by architects, and complex computer programme to assess energy efficiency
- Fibre connection means they can send and receive large files electronically, and can compete successfully with competitors more local to potential clients
- Ability to locate in their home town has kept office accommodation costs down and they can pop home for their lunch.
